Why do we define educational goals in mentoring relationships?

The most impactful mentoring relationships are based not only on the construction of the link between mentees and mentors, but the definition of clear, concrete and shared objectives is equally or more necessary for the mentoring to be successful"

(Jean Rhodes, Center for Evidence-Based Mentoring University of Massachusetts, 2020)





What educational objectives do we work on in AFEV mentoring projects?

Self esteem, self concept and confidence

Discover one's specificities: skills, competences and abilities. Raise awareness about and value them.

Autonomy and initiative

Accompany the child/youngster to reflect on their learning process, promoting process awareness.

Motivation

Discover what you like, what excites you, open yourself to the unknown

Academic orientation and school dropout prevention

 Encourage and motivate children/ youngsters on those subjects they have most difficulties with (mathematics, language...)

Discovery of the local territory and prevention of isolation

 Detecting interests and motivations to link them to activities, initiatives, community centers in the neighborhood or city.

Critical view towards others and diversity

- Show active respect towards people, their idees, live options, beliefs and cultures
- Improve language skills

What resources and tools do we offer mentors to help them achieve their goals?

- Mandatory mentor training (11 hours)
- Supervision and follow up of the mentoring relationships by a trained professional
- Blog with tools and resources: "acompanyateca", resource maps, pedagogical files, activity guide, monthly cultural agenda (Creative Commons license with mention entandem.cat/recursos)
- Tickets for specific events (theater, concerts, exhibitions)
